Have you got your garden planted yet? This is a common salutation this time of the year. The responses that one hears to the question are varied. Some answer that they haven't had time, others blame the weather or evoke the almanac. Eventually all will get something planted even if it is just one or two tomato plants. You see, planting a garden is a sign that you love the land and if you love the land, then you love God. It is in some degree the fulfillment of one of God's commandments "to be fruitful", which is probably not what you necessarily thought that God meant.

God does want us to be fruitful for the kingdom of God. God wants us to till the soil of his kingdom, sow gospel seeds, and bring into his house the yield, to plant a garden that will grow his kingdom.

For God loves us, and desperately wants us to produce fruit for the kingdom. God craves a new Jerusalem, where all people live together in harmony, where peace and prosperity abound, where truth and justice reign. But God loves us nonetheless even though we have not yet achieved this state.

God loves us so much that God just keeps on telling us that — in stories, in sermons, in our everyday experiences. God loves us so much that he created us, and made this world for us to live in as his beloved friends. God loves us so much that he gave his only son to suffer death upon a cross. And God loves us so much that he made sure that this rejection, this defeat,

was not the end of the story. God loves us so much that the end of the story is yet to come, and it is more glorious and wonderful than we can imagine or understand. God's story and our stories are not over yet. There is still time for change, still time for new plot lines, still time to introduce new characters. There is still time to plant a new garden.

The story of salvation is not like a fairy tale; they always end with everyone living "happily ever after." But our lives are pretty rarely like that. Sometimes, then, knowing that the story is not yet over can be very good news indeed. Have you got your garden planted yet?

#### **Come Glorify God Together**

Don't use summer as an excuse to skip church! By gathering in corporate worship, we obey God's command, become equipped for Christian living, and minister to our fellow pilgrims. Consider these tips for engaging in corporate worship. First, show up— in person if you can. Examine your heart and your motivation for attending church. Lift up your eyes from earthly matters to focus on God. Come prepared. Do you need to confess anything or remove any hindrance? As you worship, consider how each part of the service displays the gospel: greeting, singing, reading scripture, praying, giving and communing.

Be careful not to compartmentalize corporate worship as separate from the rest of life. Instead, consider how you'll carry the experience into the coming week. Come ready to receive; then let that overflow fuel you for the days ahead. Come prepared to participate, knowing that worshiping together is a rehearsal for heaven. But most importantly? Just Come.


